Would a dinosaur make a good pet?

Area from curriculum you are studying

History – chronological order, knowledge and interpretation, history enquiry,

WOW: (Week 1) – Have dinosaur footprints around the field. Have a large egg that is cracked open. Ask children to investigate.

Learning Challenge 1: Did my grandparents ever see a dinosaur?

Chronological order and using words like 'past' 'before I was born' 'when I was younger'.

Learning Challenge 2: What was the world like when dinosaurs existed?

Sequence events in chronological order and give reasons for my order.

Learning Challenge 3: Were all dinosaurs the same?

Use a range of appropriate words and phrases to describe the past.

Learning Challenge 4: Who's your favourite dinosaur and why?

Linked to Maths – graphs to record findings

Learning Challenge 5: How do we know about dinosaurs?

Look at a significant archaeologist from history.

Learning Challenge 6: How big is a dinosaur?
